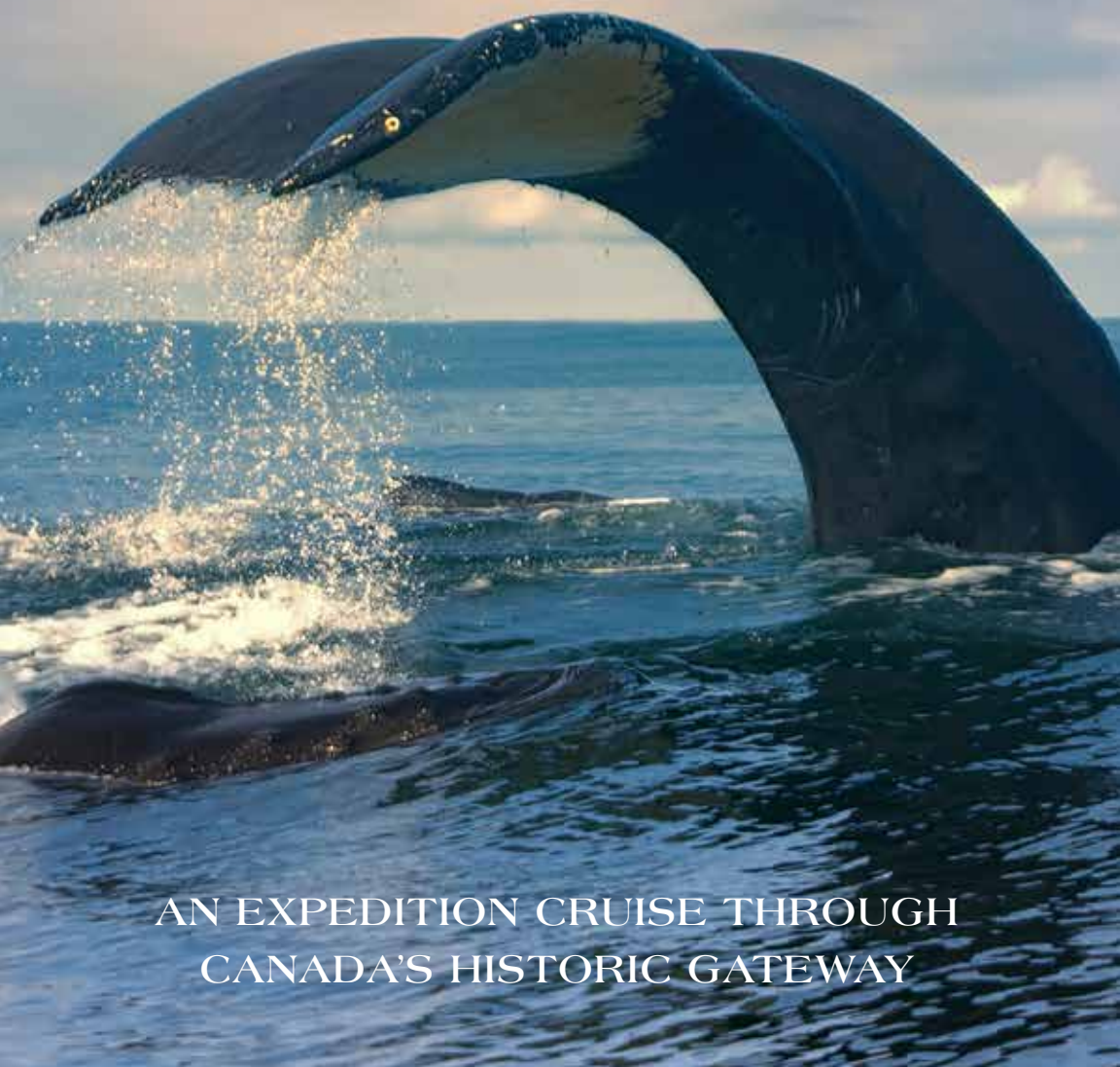

Part of an area historically known as “New France,” this vital waterway with its picturesque islands is home to a boundless variety of wildlife under the sea and on land.

Begin in Quebec City—one of the oldest settlements in North America and whose Old Town is a UNESCO World Heritage Site—before embarking upon the *Ocean Endeavour* for 10 days cruising the seaway, with extensive time to explore the area during Zodiac excursions, an optional sea kayaking adventure, and various shore landings.

While on board, keep a keen eye out for whales and other marine animals—this seaway is the second most popular place to see blue whales. During on-shore excursions, venture into glorious national parks and scenic wilderness areas to spot for a vast array of bird species and a plethora of other wildlife.

Tour seaside towns boasting a strong seafaring tradition, dine on mouthwatering local dishes, and learn about the spirited residents who have made these remote outposts their home for centuries.

Activity Level: We expect that guests be sure-footed on stairs and ramps, and be comfortable managing landings on various terrain and boarding small vessels—both from shore and the ship's deck. Ship staff will assist guests during each landing. Off the ship, a fair amount of walking on varying terrain is to be expected. It is our expectation that guests on this program are able to walk a mile on uneven and slippery terrain at a moderate pace, get in and out of a motor coach, and walk up a flight of stairs without assistance.

- Spot for the 13 species of cetaceans found in the Gulf—ideally sighted at this time of year—including fin, minke, humpback, and blue whales.
- Cruise Percé Rock by Zodiac for unbeatable views.
- Discover the rich cultural heritage and stunning red sandstone cliffs of the Magdalen Islands.
- Visit three provinces and the French island of Saint-Pierre.
- **What's Included:** 1 night hotel accommodations in Quebec City prior to embarkation and 1 night hotel accommodations in St. John's after disembarkation; 10 nights accommodations aboard the recently renovated *Ocean Endeavour*; a welcome reception in Quebec City, 12 breakfasts, 11 lunches, and 10 dinners; 24-hour self-service coffee and tea facilities onboard; all unique activities and excursions detailed in the 13-day itinerary; admission and transportation to all locations listed on the itinerary; all port fees; full guiding services of onboard naturalists and expert guides; Nikon camera instructional program onboard; your own expedition jacket to keep; gratuities to Orbridge Expedition Leader, drivers, porters, and Quebec City and St. John's hotel housekeeping staff and wait staff for included meals; and airport transfers for guests arriving and departing during the suggested times.

The *Ocean Endeavour* is the perfect vessel for expedition cruising. Outfitted with 20 Zodiacs, advanced navigation equipment, a top deck observation room, and stabilizers, she is designed to provide guests with remarkable sailing experiences throughout the Saint Lawrence Seaway.

Recently upgraded in 2016, this 449-foot vessel offers the comforts of a boutique hotel including modern interior spaces with three lounges, a gym, spa, ample exterior deck featuring lounge chairs, heated swimming pool, two saunas, hot tub, plus well-designed staterooms for a restful night's sleep after a full day of exploration.

During leisure time, visit the cozy library featuring a rich selection of reference books on the region, take a yoga class, or schedule a revitalizing massage at the spa.

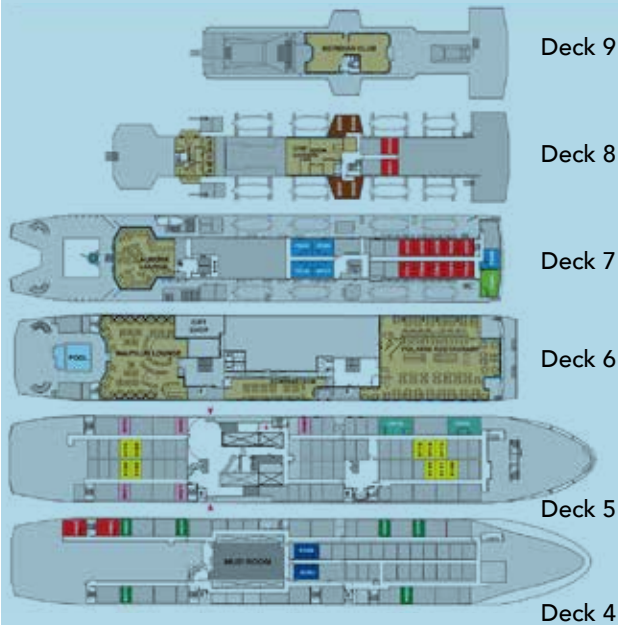
