- Discover the ruins of St. Magnus Cathedral and the 900-year-old Roystovan, the oldest wooden house in Europe.

- Embark specially designed boats for a private cruise and the chance to touch ice blocks broken from Breidamerkurjökull.
- Visit Heimaey Island for a tour of the Herjólfsdalur valley and its Viking ruins.
- Continue to Stórhöfði's lava fields of Eldfell, known as the "Pompeii of the North," and tour the Eldheimar Museum.
- Cruise along Iceland's Surtsey, one of Earth's youngest islands and a UNESCO World Heritage Site.
